## Dear Parents,

This is the latest parental questionnaires which we carried out in paper format at the spring 2018 parent consultations. Thank you so much for your engagement with this. We have analysed the feedback and worked out the percentages (rounded to nearest whole number). We had 149 responses: (28 FS, 23 Y1, 24 Y2, 24 Y3, 27 Y5, and 23 Y6) giving us a good picture of your views on the school. We will make Y4 questionnaires available at their parent consultations which have been moved to the summer due to staff absence.

We will discuss as a staff what we need to improve on our return in the summer break and we want you to know that we do listen to what you are saying. ## What could we do better?

- More opportunities for children to represent the school in teams rather than some children being selected to make children feel a little more valued and encouraged especially if they participate in that particular sport outside of school
- Communications regarding progress and home support
- Proofreading letters before they are sent out
- More forest school and focus on the environment, introduce school recycling and plastic schemes
- Give all pupils a fair chance at taking a lead role in assemblies even the shy ones so it is not always the same children parents do notice!
- Making sure music lessons happen and when they don't, like to be informed
- Less rigidity and more realistic dealing with trivial things like forgotten PE kit and more consistency between year groups
- Sharing afternoons don't work. Lack of music
- Communication regarding child's progress
- Have some kind of acknowledgement (certificate?) if children complete all their homework challenges in a term in KS2 (as they do in KS1)
- No recognition of 100% attendance this year
- School gate in mornings keeps opening later than 8.35am
- Let parents know if there are events they can attend, e.g. squash, cross country
- Keep hold of the best staff and head teacher!
- Be more discreet if an incident has occurred at school and a parent needs to be advised. No
  parent wants their private business discussed in front of the whole playground
- Open gate at 8.35am in the morning
- Expectations of children in terms of being independent are too high, the link in terms of communication with parents needs to be better as it can be frustrating and at times worrying

- Some aggression by individuals at playtimes
- Equal opportunity for girls and boys, especially in football where we observe on an unsatisfactory approach in the allocation of spaces
- We really think the entrance and the driveway leading up to the school could do with some tender loving care, especially where the cars are parked and the hedge where parents pass each other making it very awkward to pass others to and from school
- Nothing it is all good
- I'm very pleased with the support my child has had my child, letting him to go to appointments and support
- I would like to see the school take a stronger stance on disruptive behaviour and bullying within the regulatory framework to minimise disruption to other class members
- Communication regarding events sometimes a bit late
- More practical learning and more sport would be nice
- More warning of events happening in school would be helpful particularly for parents who work. At least three weeks with times not just the date
- More regular feedback in the planner
- I have struggled with my child's handwriting in Y1 and feel that learning cursive writing earlier may be beneficial
- I am not sure that six year olds should be encouraged to work on the computer as often as advised
- Larger variety of books sent home for first stage picture stories to encourage and engage
- External walkways/paths need improving/concreting to remove mud/puddles
- More communication with everything, for example, when a child is hurt in school time/upset, put on traffic light system, teachers/TA at gate in mornings for handover
- Perhaps more homework in FS; suggestion on APPs to help with maths especially please
- We can't think of anything! We are very happy thank you.
- More in-depth feedback on progress in FS if possible!
- Communications and parental involvement

Rest assured, we are listening to what you are saying. Sometimes it is not always possible to carry out wishes but all suggestions are discussed as a school. Do come and talk about anything you raised in the questionnaires that you feel needs further clarification.

When all of our parents feel listened to and would recommend our school, we know that we are highly effective in our core purpose. Thank you for contributing your views. This has been a very useful exercise and as usual and has celebrated what we do well whilst also giving us food for thought.
