Uniform

Please remember to name all uniform including the PE jackets, and outer clothing - we are now getting hats gloves and scarves left about as well as coats. We have quite a collection of unnamed items. If it is named, when it is found, it will be taken back to the child's classroom.

Please can children wear black shoes to school on non-PE days. Boots/trainers should only be worn with the permission of the headteacher. Hair should be tied back if it flops in the face and worn up for PE, irrespective of sex. It is noticeable not all children are doing so. Ribbons/hairbands, if worn, should be blue/neutral hair colour and clips small and either blue or neutral in colour. Save all the sparkly clips and large coloured bows for when we have non-uniform days. Please make sure nail varnish is removed before coming to school.

Additionally, PE shorts, joggers and zipped jackets worn for PE should be **navy** not black—there are a few alternatives creeping in. PE top should be navy as per the uniform policy – the old style white ones with the badge may be worn until your child grows out of them – subsequent tops should be of the new kind. If your child wears 'skins' under their PE kit - these should be navy.

All jewellery including earrings (studs only - **not hoops**) must be removed for PE and necklaces/bangles are only permissible in school, where they have a religious significance. Earrings cannot be taped for PE. If your child cannot remove them and put them back in themselves they must be removed before the start of the school day. Staff are not allowed to help with earrings.
