Booking Lunches and Snacks

Please make sure that you have booked a school meal the **day before** it is to be eaten. We are getting increasing numbers of children who have neither a packed lunch nor a meal booked. The office staff should not be booking meals on your behalf. If meals are not booked it is the parents' responsibility to bring in a packed lunch.

Snacks should be fresh fruit or vegetables. They should not be raisins or 'fruit winders' which are very high in sugar (albeit natural) and therefore do not provide a sustained boost to energy. Children should have their snack in a separate pot and not in their packed lunch. A few children have specific needs which are managed differently at the discretion of the headteacher. Any children eating snacks other than fresh fruit/vegetables without permission may have their snack taken away.

Lois for learning to tie a bow so she could change the ribbon on teh class 'Christian' bear so it reflects the colours of teh church year.

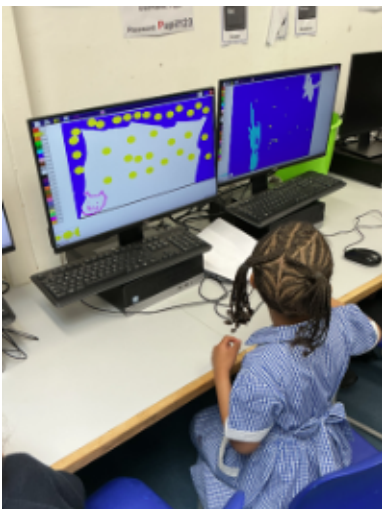
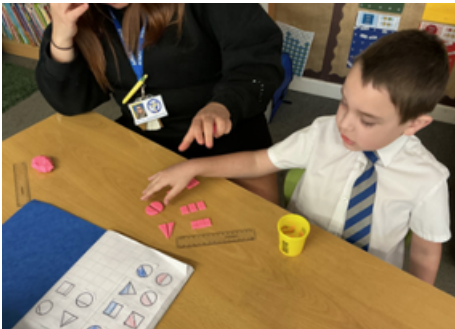
