Transport Policy

We are always very grateful for the support we receive from families to help us transport children, so we can organise many sporting activities or enrichment activities—without their support we would do far fewer.

The [transport policy](#) sets out the requirements to ensure that we have correct procedures in place. In short parents/carers if being asked by the school to transport children other than their own will need to show their current driving licence, email/ bring in a copy of their insurance certificate (having checked first that they are covered), a copy of the print out from the [vehicle enquiry service](#) and either the code for or a print out from [driving licence service](#)—both are really quick and easy to use, though you do need to know your National Insurance number for the driving licence service portal.
